Stop

COMHAIRLE DO CHLIANTCHOMHLACHTAÍ & GNÓNNA GAELTACHTA

Tacaíochtaí atá ar Fáil:

Seo a leanas na tacaíochtaí atá ar fáil do chomhlachtaí incháilithe chun cabhrú leo dul i ngleic leis na fadhbanna gnó a d'fhéadfadh éirí as COVID-19:

- **Deontas Bí Réidh** - Tá an Deontas Bí Réidh ar fáil dár gcliaint (micreafhiontair, fiontair bheaga agus mheánmhéide) a bhainfeadh tairbhe as tuilleadh taighde agus saineolas seachtrach a fháil chun plean teagmhais a ullmhú maidir le tionchar Covid-19 agus scrúdú a dhéanamh ar rioscaí a laghdú, cúrsaí sreabhadh airgid, bainistiú acmhainní daonna agus margaíocht. Deontas tacaíochta suas go €5,000 nó 50% den gcostas iomlán atá i gceist.
- **Gníomhaigh ar Thionscnaíocht** - Beidh tacaíocht ar fáil do chliantchomhlachtaí a dhéanann easpórtáil agus a bhfuil tionchar ag an víreas ar a ngnó. Soláthraíonn an tionscnamh 2 lá comhairleoireachta comhlachta gan aon chostas breise chun tacú le comhlachtaí a láidreachtaí a threisiú i dtrí réimse gnó; Bainistíocht Airgeadais, Foinsiú Straitéiseach agus Iompar & Lóistíocht.
- Cuireann an **Scéim Mheantóireachta** tacaíocht ar fáil do mheantóir gnó a chuideoidh leat i do chéim tosaithe gnó nó a thabharfaidh comhairle faoi réimsí sonracha de do phlean.
- **Airgead i bhFócas** - tacaíonn an deontas seo le cliantchomhlachtaí maoiniú suas le €7,200 chun costais táillí comhairleoireachta tríú páirtí a chlúdach. Tacaíonn an deontas le plean airgeadais agus gnó a aithníonn riachtanais airgeadais agus foinsí féideartha maoinithe a fhorbairt.

ADVICE FOR CLIENT COMPANIES & GAELTACHT BUSINESSES

Available Supports

The following are the supports available to eligible companies to help them address business problems which may arise as a result of COVID-19:

- **Be Prepared Grant** – The Be Prepared Grant is available to our clients (microenterprises, small and medium businesses) who would benefit from additional research and external expertise in preparing a contingency plan in relation to Covid-19 and examine how to reduce risk, manage cashflows, human resources and marketing. This support grant is up to €5,000 or 50% of the total cost.
- **Act On Initiative** – This support will be available to client companies which export and whose businesses will be affected by the virus. It will provide access to 2 days consultancy engagement at no extra cost to assess financial management, strategic sourcing and transport and logistics advice.
- The **Mentoring Scheme** provides support for a business mentor to assist you in the initial stage of your business or who will give advice on specific areas of your business plan.
- **Finance in Focus** – offers clients funding of up to €7,200 to cover third party consultant's fees. The grant supports the development of a financial and business plan that identifies funding needs and potential sources of funding.

Cothabháil agus Forbairt Gnó:

- **Staidéar Féidearthachta** - tá deontais ar fáil chun measúnacht a dhéanamh ar inmharthanacht do choincheap gnó.
- **Deontas caipitil** – is féidir é sin a íoc i gcás ina bhfuil infheistíocht chéaduaire á dhéanamh i sócmhainní dochta ar nós foirgnimh, fearas agus innealra agus i sócmhainní doláimhsithe a chruthaítear le haistriú teicneolaíochta trí sheilbh a fháil ar chearta paitinne, ar cheadúnais nó ar eolas teicniúil nach bhfuil paitinn air.
- Cuireann an **deontas fostaíochta** tacaíocht ar fáil chun cuidiú le fostaíthe nua a earcú.

- **Athbhreithniú ar Mhargadh Straitéiseach** – tacaíocht deontais chun straitéis forbartha margaíochta a athbhreithniú agus a fhorbairt le cabhair ó chomhairleoir seachtrach.
- **Ciste d'Aimsiú Margaidh** – Is í an aidhm atá leis an deontas seo ná comhlachtaí a spreagadh chun straitéisí inmharthana agus inbhuanaithe a bhreithniú chun teacht ar mhargaí nua tíreolaíochta.
- **Tús do Chéimithe** – déantar céimithe agus comhlachtaí a mheaitseáil lena chéile chun pleananna a fhorbairt agus a chur i gcrích atá dírithe ar fhás margaí lárnacha. Tugtar tacaíocht do thuarastal agus d'oiliúint an chéimí.

Tacaíochtaí d'Fheabhsú Táirgíochta agus Próiseas Gnó:

Deontas Nuálaíochta, Ciste Nuálaíochta Agile, Ciste TF&N, Nuálaíocht Ghnó agus Comhpháirtíocht & Dearbhán Nuálaíochta, cuidíonn siad seo ar fad le comhlachtaí chun forbairt a dhéanamh ar mhargaí nua, teicneolaíochtaí, táirgthe, próisis agus comhghuaillíochtaí straitéiseacha chun feabhas a chur ar a n-ábaltacht feidhmiú i margaí thar a bheith iomaíoch.

Tacaíochtaí Forbartha Bainistíochta:

Clár Meantóireachta, Comhairleoireacht Straitéiseach, Príomhbhainisteoir, tacaíonn siad seo leis an gcostas a bhaineann le tionscnamh nua straitéiseach forbartha a phleanáil nó a chur i bhfeidhm i do chomhlacht; agus scileanna agus saineolas lárnach a thabhairt d'fhoireann ardbhainistíochta an chomhlachta agus dúshlán a chur ar na fiontair bheaga agus mheánmhéide chun a ngnó a fhás agus a fhorbairt.

Tacaíochtaí chun cuidiú le hIomaíocht:

Deontais Lean Start, Lean Plus agus Lean Transform, Green Start agus Green Plus - Tugann na Tacaíochtaí d'Fheabhsú Táirgíochta agus Próiseas Gnó tacaíocht do chomhlachtaí chun a bhfeidhmíocht agus a n-iomaíocht a fheabhsú agus a mhéadú agus éifeachtúlacht na gcomhlachtaí a thiomáint.

Maintaining and Developing Business:

- **Feasibility Study** – The feasibility study grant aid is available to assess the viability of a business idea.
- **Capital Grant** – A capital grant may be given to enterprises seeking aid for an initial investment for capital expenditure costs in material and immaterial assets. Material assets refers to assets relating to land, building and plant and machinery. Immaterial assets refer to assets entailed by the transfer of technology through the acquisition of patent rights, licences know-how or unpatented technical knowledge.
- **Employment grants** provide support towards the recruitment of additional employees.
- **Training grants** provide assistance for training programmes that train or up-skill employees.
- **Share Capital Investment** - An tÚdarás can take an equity stake in small and medium enterprises in the start-up and expansion phases where this is of strategic importance to the development of the enterprise.

Support the assist with Internationalisation:

- **Strategic Market Review** – a grant support to review and develop a marketing development strategy with the help of an external consultant.
- **Market Discovery Fund** – This support aims to incentivise companies to undertake market research and develop viable and sustainable market entry strategies in new geographic markets.
- **Grad Start** – graduates and companies are matched to develop and implement plans which focus on growing central markets. Support is provided for the training and salary of graduates.

Productivity and Business Process Improvement Supports:

Innovation Grant, Agile Innovation Fund, RD&I Fund, Business Innovation and Innovation Vouchers & Partnerships, all assist to develop new markets, technologies, products, strategic processes and partnerships to improve their ability to operate in highly competitive markets.

Management Development Supports

Mentoring Programme, Strategic Consultancy, Key Manager, - these supports assist with the costs associated with planning or implementing a new strategic development initiative in your business; introduce key skills and expertise to the company's senior management team and challenge SMEs/larger companies to grow and develop their business.

Supports to aid Competitiveness:

Lean Start, Lean Plus and Lean Transform, Green Start and Green Plus Grants - these Productivity and Business Process Improvement Supports help companies to improve and increase performance and competitiveness and to drive the effectiveness of their businesses.

COMHAIRLE GNÓ

Tá géarchéim COVID-19 ag cruthú dúshlán airgeadais thromchúiseacha agus láithreacha d'fhiontair. Seo roinnt céimeanna praiticiúla ar féidir leat a thógáil:

1. Labhair le do bhanc. Tá na bainc tar éis a fhógairt go mbeidh siad solúbtha lena gcuid custaiméirí, agus go mb'fhéidir go mbeadh siad in ann áiseanna ó thaobh saoire íocaíochta nó caipiteal oibre éigeandála a chur ar fáil.
2. Déan bainistiú ar do shreabhadh airgid láithreach. Féach ar an scóip maidir le:
 - Costais athraitheacha a laghdú
 - Moill a chur ar chaiteachas lánroghnach
 - Síneadh a chur le hiníocaíochtaí
 - Dlús a chur faoi do chuid infháltais
 - Roghanna maidir le maoiniú slabhra soláthair a fhiosrú
3. Úsáid tacaíochtaí rialtais atá ar fáil maidir le caipiteal oibre.
 - Tugann an **Scéim Ráthaíochta Creidmheasa** tacaíochtaí iasachta suas go €1 milliún do thréimhsí suas go 7 mbliana. Is féidir iarratais a dhéanamh le Banc-Aontas Éireann, Banc na hÉireann agus Banc Uladh. Critéir cháilitheachta i gceist
 - Is féidir le Micreafhiontair teacht ar **iasachtaí COVID-19** suas go €50,000 ó MicroFinance Ireland. Iasachtaí ar fáil ag rátaí úis idir 6.8% agus 7.8%. Is féidir le gnóthaí iarratas a dhéanamh díreach le microfinanceireland.ie. Critéir cháilitheachta i gceist
 - Beidh an **Scéim Caipitil Oibre €200m SBCI Covid-19** do ghnóthaí incháilithe ar fáil faoi cheann seachtaine. Is í an iasacht is mó ná €1.5 milliún (an chéad €500,000 neamhurraithe) agus is 4% a bheidh uasmhéid an ráta úis. Is féidir iarratas a dhéanamh anseo ag láithreán gréasáin SBCI sbci.gov.ie. Critéir cháilitheachta i gceist
 - Tá **Pacáiste €200m do Thacaíochtaí Fiontair** le Scéim Tarrthála agus Athstruchtúraithe ar fáil trí Fhiontraíocht Éireann do chomhlachtaí inmharthana ach leochaileach a dteastaíonn athstruchtúrú nó athrú uathu.
4. Téigh i gcomhairle le do chuntasóir nó úsáid an tacaíocht chomhairleach atá ar fáil ó Údarás na Gaeltachta
5. Seiceáil do pholasaí árachais agus féach an gclúdaítear cuir isteach ar do ghnó, nó dúnadh sealadach do ghnó, de bharr Covid-19

BUSINESS ADVICE

The COVID-19 crisis is creating serious and immediate financial challenges for businesses. Here are some practical steps you can take:

- 1. Talk to your bank.** All the banks have announced that they will offer flexibility to their customers, and they may be able to provide payment holidays or emergency working capital facilities.
- 2. Take immediate steps to manage your cashflows. Look for scope to:**
 - Lower variable costs
 - Delay discretionary spend
 - Extend your payables
 - Expedite your receivables
 - Explore supply chain financing options *Costais athraitheacha a laghdú*
- 3. Use available government supports for working capital.**
 - The **Credit Guarantee Scheme** supports loans up to €1 million for periods of up to 7 years. Applications can be made to AIB, Bank of Ireland and Ulster Bank. **Eligibility criteria apply.**
 - **Microenterprises**, can access **COVID-19 loans** of up to €50,000 from **MicroFinance Ireland**. Loans are available at an interest rate of between 6.8% and 7.8%. Businesses can apply directly at microfinanceireland.ie. **Eligibility criteria apply.**
 - The **€200m SBCI Covid-19 Working Capital Scheme** for eligible businesses will be available within the next week. Maximum loan size will be €1.5 million (first €500,000 unsecured) and the maximum interest rate will be 4%. Applications can be made through the SBCI website at sbc.gov.ie. **Eligibility criteria apply.**
 - A **€200m Package for Enterprise Supports** including a Rescue and Restructuring Scheme is available through Enterprise Ireland for vulnerable but viable firms that need to restructure or transform their business.
- 4. Get advice from your accountant or use the advisory support available from Údarás na Gaeltachta.**
- 5. Check if your insurance policy covers you for an interruption in your business, or a temporary business closure, caused by Covid-19**

- **Tuairisceáin Chánach:** ba cheart do ghnóthaí a bhfuil deacrachtaí sealadacha acu maidir le sreabhadh airgid leanúint ar aghaidh ag cur ag gcuid tuairisceán cánach isteach in am
- **Gearradh Úis:** tá an t-ús a ghearrtar ar íocaíochtaí déanacha curtha ar fionraí i leith dhliteanais CBL mhí Eanáir/Feabhra agus i leith dhliteanais ÍMAT (Fostóra) mhí Feabhra agus mhí an Mhárta araon
- **Forfheidhmiúchán Fiachais:** Tá na gníomhaíochtaí ar fad forfheidhmiúcháin fiachais curtha ar fionraí go dtí go dtugtar fógra eile
- **Imréiteach Cánach:** leanfaidh an stádas reatha imréitigh cánach i bhfeidhm do gach gnó thar na míonna amach romhainn

7. Tabhair ar aird go bhfuil tacaíochtaí eile Rialtais ar fáil. Mar shampla:

- Is féidir le comhlachtaí a chaithfidh uaireanta nó laethanta oibre a laghdú cur isteach ar Thacaíocht Ghearrthéarmach Oibre Choimirce Sóisialaí na Roinne Gnóthaí Fostaíochta agus Coimirce Sóisialaí trí theagmháil a dhéanamh le hOifig áitiúil Intreo,
- Cuirfidh an Roinn Gnóthaí Fostaíochta agus Coimirce Sóisialaí agus an Roinn Gnó, Fiontar agus Nuálaíochta seirbhís tacaíochta Chéad Freagróra ar fáil tríd Oifigí Intreo agus na gníomhaireachtaí forbartha Fiontraíocht Éireann agus an tÚdarás Forbartha Tionscail i ngach réigiún chun tacaíochtaí saincheaptha a chur ar fáil do chomhlachtaí atá buailte agus an aidhm a bheidh leo ná scaoileadh chun bóthair ollmhór a sheachaint agus am a thabhairt do chomhlachtaí dul i ngleic le constaicí gearrthéarmacha.

6. If you have concerns about your ability to pay your tax liabilities speak to the Revenue Commissioners, who have advised:

- **Tax Returns:** businesses experiencing temporary cash flow difficulties should continue to send in tax returns on time.
- **Application of Interest:** the application of interest on late payments is suspended for January/February VAT and both February and March PAYE (Employers) liabilities.
- **Debt Enforcement:** All debt enforcement activity is suspended until further notice.
- **Tax Clearance:** current tax clearance status will remain in place for all businesses over the coming months.

7. Be aware of other government supports available. For example:

- The Department of Employment Affairs and Social Protection and the Department of Business, Enterprise and Innovation will provide a joint First Responder support service through the Intreo Offices in each region to provide tailored supports for impacted firms, with the objective of avoiding mass lay-offs and buying time for firms to work through the short-term disruptions.

Beidh Aonad Forbartha Pobail Údarás na Gaeltachta agus feidhmeannaigh an Údaráis ar fáil mar is gnáth, ar an bhfón agus ríomhphost, do na heagrais forbartha pobail. ADVICE FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ORGANISATIONS

Údarás na Gaeltachta is working closely with the community development organisations under our aegis to ensure that they have the proper supports and information available to them. We recommend that the community development organisations continue to follow the guidance from State health agencies in relation to Covid-19, in addition we also specifically recommend:

- Employees of community development organisations who can work from home are to do so from 13/03/2020 until 29/03/2020 or until otherwise stated, but that they have the option to work from the office if that is more suitable,
- Meetings, training courses or other organised events which would bring people together indoors, and which are not of vital importance, be cancelled,
- You should work from home if you, or a member of your family, have a health condition,
- You should work from home if you have difficulties with childcare as a result of the school closures

At this juncture, there has been no official guidance that the offices in which you work are to be closed. Having said that it is recommended that you follow the recommendations and guidance issued by the Health Service Executive in relation to COVID-19.

The Údarás na Gaeltachta Aonad Forbartha Pobail (Community Development Unit) and Údarás executives will be available to community development organisations as usual, by phone and email. Meetings can be arranged online or on the phone but we are advising that meetings do not take place on location.

Údarás na Gaeltachta has had discussions with the Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht to ensure that in the coming weeks that funding mechanisms remain functional to facilitate operational grant claims in the usual manner in the weeks ahead.

These arrangements will be in place until other official guidance is given by the relevant Government departments.

Supervisors

- At this juncture, there has been no official guidance that the offices in which you work are to be closed, that said, it is recommended that you follow the recommendations and guidance issued by the Health Service Executive in relation to COVID-19.
- All training courses/meetings organised by Supervisors are to be cancelled,
- You should consult with the locations/centres in which participants are working to ensure that they are aware of the guidance which allows for participants to stay at home from now until further notice,

- Until further notice, participants are being released from their duties for an undetermined period. Basically, participants will be staying at home from now on. Arrangements will be made in the future on how the relevant hours can be worked back.
